Every Day You are Taking Away the Pain of Hunger by Feeding Seniors, Children, and their Families

See how your generosity has eased the burden for those struggling to make ends meet

This year continues to present serious hardships for working families and seniors on fixed incomes. Between the high cost of housing, gas prices and increased cost of food at the grocery store it is impossible for those struggling in poverty to purchase enough food

Every day, parents and seniors come to the center for food and essentials such as toothpaste. They do not need an appointment which removes the barriers that can make it difficult for working parents to receive the help they need.

With 30% more family visits and over 23,850 more meals being distributed this year compared to one year ago, the huge need for food persists.

We were thankful to receive a grant from the DuPage Community Transformation Partnership to purchase a new electric van. Having a second van has enabled us to expand our capacity to pick up more food at grocery stores, while continuing to make weekly pickups at the Northern Illinois Food Bank. Food and fresh produce continues to be purchased weekly along with grocery recovery.

Your support made it possible to expand the Children's Project and 105 more children are enrolled in the program than a year ago. In our strategic planning, our path

forward was to expand the program to serve this number of children in two years, but people need help now. Enrollment makes it possible for families to have weekly access to nutritious meals, birthday boxes and school supplies for their children.

The number of seniors on our active waiting list continues to rise. While these treasured seniors are waiting to be enrolled in the Senior Citizen Project they receive a small gift card each month. They, along with those enrolled in the Senior Citizen Project, can also come to the center for nutritious food every week.

Seniors like 73-year-old Jackie who has lost all her family, including her beloved son comes every week without fail. Jackie picks up fresh produce and groceries that fit her very specific dietary needs. Jackie wrote in her thank you card, "I want to thank you for everything you do, and for being so nice and caring and

Lisa was very emotional when Jennifer, the Children's Project Coordinator gave her school supplies, art sets and stuffed animals for the 3, 11, and 12-year-old children to sleep with. Since enrollment, there has not been a week that has gone by that Lisa has not come for produce, groceries, and essentials.


Secret Pals are a Lifeline






